We Are Called to Be Great Lovers

A Member of Congress told an audience about a kindergarten class preparing to act out the Christmas story for their parents.

The children practiced hard, and the teacher gave extra attention to the little boy who was to play the role of the innkeeper. He had Down Syndrome, and everyone helped him rehearse his two words over and over: “No room. No room.”

When the day of the program arrived, the children were nervous and excited as they took their places on the stage. Some tripped on their costumes and others forgot their lines, but the play went on as planned until the part when Mary and Joseph knocked on the door of the inn.

Instead of hearing the words “no room” and having the door slammed in their faces, the little boy with Down Syndrome flung the door wide and said cheerily, “Come on in. I’ve been waiting for you.”

Cherish the Children

Front: Cherish the Children

Back:

... Because they are the “greatest.”

“Whoever humbles himself like this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven” (Matthew 18:4 NIV).

Jesus uses a child to redefine greatness. The “greatest” is the one who, like a child, is in greatest need of care, nurture, and protection. A “child” is anyone who is vulnerable, unable to help themselves. Thus, a “child” is: the baby in the womb, the pregnant teen, the post-abortive man or women, the elderly, the ill, and people with disabilities.

... Because they are Jesus.

“And whoever welcomes a little child like this in My name welcomes Me” (Matthew 18:5 NIV).

Jesus uses a child to teach true compassion. Compassion means to “suffer with.” It is not compassionate to eliminate those who suffer or those we think will suffer. Compassion involves caring for and helping those unable to help themselves. Compassion is serving Jesus in our service to others.

... Because they are precious.

“See that you do not look down on one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of My Father in heaven” (Matthew 18:10-11 NIV).

Jesus uses a child to show how precious life is. Those in need are known and valued by our heavenly Father. God exalts the lowly. This is what He calls us to do.

So Cherish the Children ...

Conceived by the Holy Spirit

Front:

What do you think of when you say in the Apostles’ Creed that Jesus was “conceived by the Holy Spirit”? Do you ponder that mystery, or do you rush on to “born of the virgin Mary”? The latter is a little easier to understand this time of year because we have all those pretty manger scenes in our heads. We see depictions of baby Jesus lying in a manger. We sing songs about the “little Lord Jesus asleep on the hay.” A group was asked how God came into the world. “As a baby,” was their answer. True enough, but . . .

Before Jesus was born of the virgin Mary, He was conceived by the Holy Spirit. It is important to understand that Jesus spent nine months in a womb before He was “asleep on the hay.” It is particularly important in light of the attention given to stem cells and cloning these days.

Back:

A more precise answer to the question of how God came into the world is “As a zygote!” A zygote is the name given to what human beings look like at the one-cell stage.

This picture is what each of us once looked like. It is what Jesus looked like nine months before birth as He began his prenatal growth toward December 25th. I’ll grant you that it is not exactly conducive to inspiring great works of art or memorable musical melodies, and I doubt you will receive many Christmas cards with this on the front. Nevertheless, it has profound implications for all of humanity.

Psalm 51:5 (“Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me”) reminds us that all of humanity was sinful from the moment of conception.

The implication, therefore, is that we were human beings from the moment of conception. We were human beings in need of salvation from the moment of conception. That is why God sent Jesus as a zygote. We were sinful zygotes. He took our place as a holy Zygote.

“Since the children have flesh and blood, He too shared in their humanity so that by His death He might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is the devil” Hebrews 2:14.

In order to redeem us, Jesus had to become just as we were except without sin (Hebrews 4:15). Jesus’ conception as a holy zygote attests to our humanity from the moment of conception.

Therefore, it is not just a five-day-old growth of cells that are destroyed when stem cells are extracted. A five-day-old human being, for whom Jesus was conceived, born, suffered, crucified, died, and rose again is destroyed. It is not just stem cells that are extracted. These are the body parts of a living human being. If a zygote would be cloned, he or she would be a living human being, a genetic twin of someone else. Although cloning is contrary to the will and ways of God for procreation and we should vigorously oppose it, once a cloned zygote exists he or she should not be subject to mutilation and experimentation.

So the next time you say that Jesus was “conceived by the Holy Spirit,” remember that you are saying all you really need to know when it comes to deciding the rightness or wrongness of embryonic stem cell research.

God is a Faithful Father

“If we confess our sins, [God] is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness” (1 John 1:9 ESV).

To celebrate the joys ... **“My soul magnifies the Lord”** Luke 1:46.

To be comforted in sorrow ... **“And his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation”** Luke 1:50.

Back: In life ... people who live under the shadow of the cross look at life differently.

Christ’s presence on the cross assures us of His love (1 John 4:9).

Christ’s presence in Word and Sacrament assures us nothing can separate us from the love of the cross (Romans 8:31-39).

Christ’s presence and saving purpose in the suffering of the cross assures us of His presence and purpose in our suffering (1 Peter 1:6-9).

It is the abiding presence of Christ that gives purpose to every life: People who are healthy, People who are ill, People with disabilities • People who are unconscious.

Christ is exalted in people’s lives not because of what they are able to do, but because of what Christ does through them. As long as God gives life, He gives life meaning and purpose. Thus, we must never intend for someone to die. We can confidently pray in life: “In cloud and sunshine, oh, abide with me.”

In death ... people who live under the shadow of the cross look at death differently.

Christ’s presence on the cross destroyed the powers of darkness (Colossians 2:15).

Christ’s presence in Word and Sacrament assures us we are united with Him in His death and resurrection (1 Corinthians 11:26; Romans 6:4).

Christ’s presence at the right hand of the Father assures us of a place in heaven when we die (John 14:1-3).

It is the abiding presence of Christ that gives meaning to death.

Death has been swallowed up in victory (1 Corinthians 15:54).

To die is gain (Philippians 1:21).

“Death is but the narrow gate to life.” (Martin Luther)

Christ is exalted in the death of a Christian because of what He has done to destroy death and bring life and immortality (2 Timothy 1:10). It is okay to allow those who are dying to die according to God’s timetable. Not everything that can be done needs to be done. We can confidently pray in death, “I triumph still if Thou abide with me.”



In the Beginning ... was Life!

Front: In the Beginning ... was Life!

Created/Formed/Redeemed

Back: *The Beginning of Time:*

“God created the heavens and the earth” (Genesis 1:1). Everything God created was created **For Life**, to sustain, perpetuate, and enhance human life. Light, sky, dry land and seas, vegetation, heavenly bodies, fish, birds, animals—all were in preparation for, **“Let us make man in our image”** (Genesis 1:26). Human life is not the result of a series of random events. It is the result of a six-day series of divinely-designed events that formed the backdrop for human life.

Your Beginning:

“Your hands shaped me and formed me” (Psalm 119:73). The creative hand of God continues to be at work through the biological process He set into motion when He told Adam and Eve to be **“fruitful and multiply.”** Because of God’s “hands on” involvement in the beginning of every human life, we can say with the Psalmist, **“I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made”** (Psalm 139:14).

New Beginning:

“In Him was life . . .” (John 1:4). The world we live in is the one God created, but it is not *like* the one He created. Sin devastated creation and the creature who was creation’s crown. But God still loved what His hands had made! He sent His Son who stretched out His hands on a cross. The suffering and death of His own Son demonstrated the value God places on human life. Through faith in the resurrected Jesus, we have a brand new beginning!

These are the “beginnings” that give value to every human life.

They are where we begin when faced with difficult choices about life. Before asking, “What should I do?” we ask, “What has God done?” His Word tells us that He has endowed human life with value through His creating and redeeming hands. We value human life at all stages and under all conditions because God does!



In the Hand of God

Front: In the Hand of God. “In His hand is the life of every living thing and the breath of all mankind.” Job 12:10 *ESV*

Back:

The Value of Life Comes from the Hand of God.

He Creates Life With His Hands: “Your hands fashioned and made me.” (Job 10:8a)

He Redeemed Life With His Hands: “Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, ‘Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree.’” (Galatians 3:13)

He Calls Us and Holds Us With His Hand: “I am the LORD; I have called you in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you.” (Isaiah 42:6a)

As His People, We Value Life as the Work of His Hand By ...

Boldly speaking up for and protecting the life His hands create.

Reaching out with His forgiving hands to those who have made mistakes.

Offering His hand of hope to those hurting and struggling.



Jesus Loves Children

Front: *I Knew You* painting by Shannon Wirrenga. Text: **“Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you. Before you were born, I set you apart.”** Jeremiah 3:15

Back:

“People were bringing little children to Jesus to have Him touch them, but the disciples rebuked them.” Mark 10:13

Why did they do it? Why did the disciples attempt to keep little children from Jesus? They must have believed they had a good reason—the children would be an inconvenience.

Rape, incest, fetal abnormality, the mother’s life—many today believe these are the reasons for most abortions. Not so! The sad truth is that 93% of abortions are performed because the child is perceived to be an inconvenience.

Studies show the top three reasons for abortion are: (Source – The Alan Guttmacher Institute 2/2000)

“A baby at this time would interfere with work, school, or other responsibilities.”

“I cannot afford a baby.”

“I do not want to be a single parent” or “I’m having problems” with husband or partner.

Jesus loved His disciples and would forgive them. But still, He was **“indignant”** at their choice. His choice was to, **“Let the little children come to Me.”**

Jesus also loves His people today and will forgive those whose hearts have been broken by a choice they know they should not have made. But still, He cannot be pleased when 3,200 little children everyday are kept from ever learning about Him.

Why? Jesus loves children. His choice is still the same, **“Let the little children come to me.”** Mark 10:14a

“And He took them in His arms, put His hands on them, and blessed them.” Mark 10:1

Just Imagine

Front: Just Imagine ... what will this baby be? “I know the plans I have for you ... to prosper you and not to harm you ... to give you hope and a future.”
GOD Jeremiah 29:11

Back:

God’s Word, from Jeremiah 29:10-14, brought hope to His distressed people in exile and can bring hope to distressed people today ...

... a woman whose plans have been disrupted by an unplanned pregnancy and who, understandably, imagines the worst.

... a woman hopeless about the future because of the guilt of a past abortion.

... a man who encouraged the mother of his child to have an abortion.

God’s Word also expresses the hope that God has for every unborn child.

Just Imagine **what God’s plans for this baby might be . . .**

... someone to love and care for!

... a messenger of hope that life should go on!

... a friend, neighbor, teacher, pastor, missionary, laborer, farmer, spouse, parent, grandparent!

Just Imagine **God’s plan to work in and through this child’s life to make a difference in the world, in His kingdom.**

Abortion brings an end to a life and to God’s plan for that life.

Abortion says “no thanks!” to God’s gift of life.

Abortion stops the beating heart of a child and pierces the heart of a mother.

There is another choice—trusting in the power of the Giver of Life!

“Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen.” (Ephesians 3:20-21)

Just Imagine . . .

... the full dimensions of God’s love (Ephesians 3:18).
His love in Christ is more than you can imagine.

... the fullness of the power of God at work in you (Ephesians 3:19). **His power is more than you can imagine.**

... the full cleansing from sin that God’s power and

love have given in Jesus (1 John 1:9). **His forgiveness is more than you can imagine.**

... what God’s power and love can do in any situation (Romans 8:28). **God’s ability to accomplish His purpose is more than you can imagine.**

... what this child might be. **God’s purpose for every life is more than we can imagine!**



Life Under the Cross

Front: Life Under the Cross. “Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.” Romans 12:12.

Back:

Life Without Problems.

We know better than that. Life can be hard. Sin in the world is the reason. That is why God’s people experience: *unwanted pregnancies—terminal illness—chronic disease*. They experience the pain, suffering, and difficult decisions that these bring.

Is Death the Solution?

There are those who say “yes. That is why we have: *abortion assisted suicide euthanasia*. It becomes too easy to view *people as burdens who* would be “better off dead.”

There Is A Better Solution! It is Life Under the Cross.

Life Under the Cross says:

- People have burdens, but people are not burdens. (Psalm 72:12-14)
- Christians are called to carry each other’s burdens. (Galatians 6:2) God works through suffering. (1 John 4:10)
- God is with us in our suffering. (Romans 8:31-32)
- Better things are to come. (2 Corinthians 4:17)
- We can seek the presence of Jesus in suffering rather than seeking the absence of suffering at all costs. (Romans 5:15)

Therefore, Christians can be:

- **“joyful in hope”** – As long as God gives life, God gives life purpose.
- **“patient in affliction”** – just as God’s love was at work in the suffering of the cross, so

His love is at work in the suffering of His people.

- **“faithful in prayer”** – The cross assures us of a listening and merciful God who will not forsake us.

“[Jesus] didn’t bear the cross—he used it! There at the cross was the deepest injustice ever done, and Jesus turns it all into a healing of injustice and sin. There men were at their worst, and through it Jesus reveals God at his best. There hate was bitterest, and there Love met it and conquered it by taking it into his own heart and transforming it. The darkest hour of history becomes the lightest! The cross becomes a throne! The end—a new beginning.” E. Stanley Jones, “Christ in Human Suffering”



The Miracle of Meagerness

Front: “She gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in strips of cloth and laid him in a manger because there wasn’t any room for them in the inn.” Luke 2:7 *GOD’S WORD*

Back:

Is Christmas Miraculous? Was Jesus’ Birth

Miraculous? Jesus was born just like the rest of us. There was pain and blood and perhaps a queasy Joseph.

The Miracle Happened Nine Months Earlier. The miracle happened when “the power of the Most High” overshadowed Mary and she conceived the Son of God. After this incredible miracle, Jesus implanted in Mary’s uterine wall and developed and grew there as we all did in our own mother’s womb. Jesus’ humanity there speaks of our humanity there. His birth occurred as did all births before and after—nothing miraculous about it. Or was there?

The Miracle of Meagerness. The miracle of Jesus’ birth is seen in the completely un-miraculous nature of it all. The miracle of Christmas is the meagerness of Christmas.

It is not a mansion, but a manger, where God’s Son lays His head. It is not in the holy city of Jerusalem, but in the rather unholy village of Bethlehem, where God makes His earthly debut.

The miracle of Christmas is that God would come at all into a world that had rejected Him. But He did. And He did so in a way that excludes neither lowly shepherds nor stately kings from His presence. A Savior lying in a manger is a Savior for all—born and

unborn, healthy and frail. What a miracle!



The Miracle of the Incarnation

“Conceived by the Holy Spirit ...”

These few words from the Apostles’ Creed point to the divinity of Jesus.

He was God in the flesh from the moment of conception.

The Purpose of the Incarnation

These words also point to our humanity from the moment of conception.

The Psalmist writes, **“Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me”** (Psalm 51:5 NIV).

If we are sinful from the moment of conception, we are human beings from that moment and are in need of salvation.

Jesus began as we began and passed through all the stages of our development to redeem us from our sinful condition.

The Implications of the Incarnation

Jesus passing through all the stages of human development gives value to all human life in all stages of that development.

Jesus being “conceived by the Holy Spirit” enables us to joyfully proclaim and defend the preciousness of all human life from the moment of conception.



Welcome a Little Child

Front: Welcome a Little Child. **“When you welcome a little child you welcome me.”** (Mark 9:37)

Welcome a Little Child/Lutherans For Life

Back:

Welcome a Little Child

When Jesus said to His disciples, **“Whoever welcomes one of these little children in My name welcomes Me”** (Mark 9:37), He was teaching them about putting others and the needs of others first. He was teaching about the greatness of servanthood and sacrifice.

When a pregnant teen makes the choice of adoption for her baby, she is demonstrating greatness. She is willing to welcome a child so that he or she may be welcomed into a caring and loving family.

Making an adoption plan for a preborn child is not

easy. It takes sacrifice. It brings tears. At the same time, it acknowledges God's gift of life and is willing to do what is best for that life. Abortion kills a child and forever wounds a mother.

Adoption is a choice both mother and child can live with.

The facts agree.*

Benefits for the Adoptive Child

Teens who were adopted at birth are more likely than children born into intact families to live with two parents in a middle-class family.

Adopted children score higher than their middle class counterparts on indicators of school performance, social competency, optimism, and volunteerism.

Adopted adolescents generally are less depressed than children of single parents and less involved in alcohol abuse, vandalism, group fighting, police trouble, weapon use, and theft.

Adopted adolescents score higher than children of single parents on self-esteem, confidence in their own judgment, self-directedness, positive view of others, and feelings of security within their families.

Benefits for the Mothers

Teenage mothers who choose adoption do better than mothers who choose to be single parents.

They ...

... have higher educational aspirations, are more likely to finish school, and less likely to live in poverty and receive public assistance than mothers who keep their children.

... delay marriage longer and are more likely to marry eventually.

... are more likely to be employed 12 months after the birth and less likely to repeat out-of-wedlock pregnancy.

... are no more likely to suffer negative psychological consequences, such as depression, than are mothers who rear children as single parents.
