Iceland on Pace to Eradicate All Unborn Diagnosed with Down Syndrome—A recent CBS News *On Assignment* episode entitled “The Country Where Down Syndrome is Disappearing” finds Iceland at a nearly 100 percent abortion rate for preborn babies diagnosed with Down syndrome. The story shows the vast majority of mothers who received a positive test for the genetic disorder aborted their babies. Prenatal screenings in the Icelandic nation were introduced in the early 2000s. The news report revealed one mother aborted partly because of the pressure she felt. Of concern is Iceland’s genetic-testing accuracy at only 85 percent. Pro-life advocates question how many children with Down-syndrome diagnoses don’t actually have developmental issues.
