Abortions in the U.S. Hit Historic New Low - On September 18, the Guttmacher Institute reported a seven-percent drop in abortions across the U.S. to a new alltime low. Guttmucher records the numbers through a national census of abortion providers. According to the comprehensive abortion data, 862,320 abortions were reported in 2017, a decline from 926,200 in 2014, the report showed. The abortion rate also fell to 13.5 per 1,000 women of childbearing age—down from 14.6 in 2014 and 16.9 in 2011. According to the report, 32 states passed about 400 pro-life laws during the time period, including informed consent, parental consent, and waitingperiod requirements. The annual number of legal abortions shows a continued downward trend since its peak in the 1980s, with a slight uptick between 2006 and 2008. The analysis suggests the decline is at the lowest level of abortion on record since the U.S. Supreme Court legalized the procedure in 1973.
