Goals:

- Train and equip new student leaders on all aspects of life ministries and the work of Lutherans For Life through a summer internship program.
- Provide these students with on the job training and experience to support them in their future work in life ministries.
- Support the growth of Y4Life programs and activities by providing a short-term, part-time worker to assist the director of Y4Life

Internship Overview

- **Length-** 10 weeks during the summer (length and dates dependent on university dates and requirements)
- **Location-** Remote
- **Responsibilities-** see attached job description
- **Requirements-** All applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Currently enrolled in a university and have completed at least two years of undergraduate study at the time of the internship
 - Willing and able to travel, at minimum, 4 weeks during the internship, including training in St. Louis and travel to various conferences and events (travel expenses will be provided)
- **Compensation-** A stipend of \$1,500 will be provided
- **Academic Credit-** Lutherans For Life is willing to work with the student and their university to provide academic credit provided the goals of the internship are still adequately met.
